Closed Ulnar condyle fracture of Thumb MCP joint associated with EPL tendon injury - Case Report

Introduction - Acute disruption of Thumb ulnar collateral ligament is a common injury. Failure of the ligament commonly occurs at the base of the proximal phalanx and is sometimes associated with osseous avulsion from the Proximal phalanx.

Associated injuries to many other structures have been reported, such as disruption of the adductor aponeurosis, dorsal capsule, and volar plate (2,3,4,5,6).UCL injuries are also associated with MCP dislocation (5,7,8).

We report a case of patient who sustained osseous avulsion fracture of ulnar condyle of the proximal phalanx with EPL disruption.

Case report - 14 year old child sustained a fall on the out stretched hand and presented 3 days following the injury with pain, swelling and restricted movement right Thumb. Clinical examination revealed Tenderness at ulnar condyle region of first MCP joint and guarding with MCP valgus stress test. Despite marked guarding the patient demonstrated active IP and MCP flexion, however no active IP extension

could be appreciated. X ray showed displaced Ulnar collateral ligament avulsion fracture of MCP joint of Thumb

Surgical management was planned for displaced ulnar condyle fracture of first MCP joint.

Lazy "S" shaped incision was made on ulnar aspect of first MCP joint. Extensor expansion of MCP joint was evaluated and found to have an EPL tendon injury associated with displaced ulnar condyle fracture. 2-0 fibre wire was used to approximate ulnar condyle fracture which was then fixed with a K wire. EPL Tendon was repaired with 3-0 proline with modified Kessler technique. Thumb Abduction slab applied for 6 weeks.


K wire removed at 6 weeks followed by Rehabilitation for next 6 weeks. At 2 and half month patient had improved range of movement of MCP joint and negative stress test for MCP joint.

Discussion - This report documents the rare constellation of ulnar condyle and EPL tendon disruption. Coonrad and Goldner (5)

described a single case of proximal UCL avulsion, EPB tendon tear. Three cases of combined EPB and radial collateral ligament tears also have been reported(9). One case of associated combined EPL and EPB injury has been reported. Radial displacement of EPL tendon is commonly associated with UCL injuries (1,9) but we found no documentation of associated isolated EPL disruption.

The UCL is more likely to fail if the MCP joint is flexed at the time of trauma because its fibres are taught in flexion and loose in extension. We propose that most likely mechanism of injury for this case





was direct trauma to the dorsum of the proximal phalanx with MCP joint acutely flexed. Pure hyperabduction mechanism fails to explain the extensor tendon injury.

Although this report describes an unusual injury, the clinical evaluation of the acutely unstable thumb should include evaluation of tendon integrity so that such an injury is not missed.


